Report on User Awareness Programme

A specialised User Awareness Programme titled “Effective use of electronic resources empowers faculty to teach smarter, research deeper, and innovate continuously” was conducted on 14 February 2026 for faculty members from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM at the Library Video Conference Room, Amar Jawan Block.

The programme commenced with an introductory address by Dr. Anitha S Rai, Director of Library and Alumni Relations. She emphasised the library's commitment to providing resourceful digital content and the importance of faculty leveraging these subscriptions for institutional growth and academic excellence.

The core session was conducted by Ms. Namrata Pai, who provided a comprehensive walkthrough of the institution's subscribed E-Resources. The following categories were detailed:
